## Magnolia Grille & Main Bar

Club casual and Club Active wear will be permitted in the Magnolia Grille and Main Bar dining area:

- **Tuesday - Wednesday All Day**
- **Thursday & Friday for lunch**
- **Saturday for brunch**

Club active wear is defined as proper golf, tennis and fitness attire permitted by club policies. The following will not be permitted:

- Cleats
- Cut-offs/ Crop Tops and/or running shorts
- Pool Wear

Club casual is permitted in the Magnolia Grille and Main Bar dining areas on **Thursday - Saturdays evenings after 5:00 P.M. & Sundays for Brunch**. Club casual is defined as collared/polo shirts, sweaters, dress slacks or modest length dress shorts for men. Club casual is defined as dresses, rompers, skirts, dress shorts, blouses, turtlenecks, sweaters and slacks for women. No head wear for men will be permitted. Proper footwear should include dress shoes, fashion sneakers and dress sandals for women.

### Golf Dress Code

The following dress code shall be maintained while playing golf, using the practice facilities or receiving private and group instruction (applies to adults and juniors 12 & over). All members and invited guests are required to follow the dress code below:

1. Men must wear collared shirts with sleeves at all times.
2. Women may wear sleeveless blouses.
3. Golf or tennis shoes must be worn on the golf course at all times.

The following items are not permitted on the golf course or practice facilities:

1. Men may not wear tank tops, sleeveless shirts or T-shirts.
2. No swimming trunks, gym shorts or cutoff jeans.
3. No denim shorts or jeans.

## **Tennis Dress Code**

### **Court Attire**

The following dress code shall be maintained while using the tennis facilities:

- Only regulation tennis shoes/athletic shoes that will not mark courts will be allowed.
- Shirts and tops should be worn at all times.
- Regulation tennis tops, shorts, and skirts for ladies and girls
- Regulation tennis shorts and shirts (including tasteful short sleeved T-shirts) for men and boys
- Refer to Dress Code, section 3B of the House Rules and Regulations.

The following items are not permitted on the tennis courts:

- Demin (jeans)
- Leotards
- Visible sports bras
- Aerobic wear
- Street clothes
- Swimsuits
- High heels
- Cleats/spikes

### **Fitness Center Dress Code**

To ensure a comfortable and respectful environment for all members, we ask that all adhere to the following dress code while using our facilities.

- Appropriate Attire: Clothing should be modest and should not reveal undergarments, or any body parts that may be considered inappropriate for a public setting.
- No low-cut armhole shirts.
- Footwear: Closed-toe athletic shoes are required in all workout areas for safety reasons.
  - Not permitted: Crocs, sandals, 5-toe shoes, loafers, skate shoes.
